This morning after the heavy NE gale the harbor presented a hard sight of destruction and wreckage all our wharf and part of stage and breast work gone clean the beach swept clean of every creation, stores, flakes & c all gone, Aylwards, browns, Handcocks stages swept away, two Schooners and Sqyers motor boat drove ashore the Schooner Standard Cull on the rocks back of our stage, the Schooner Nettie M Prince on shore in gulch by Aylwards stage and Livyer's Boat with load lumber on board on the beach; the pond is strewn with wreckage of stages and stores. Our lighter, boats and the bridge hoops off Govt Wharf and all kinds of gear ex stores and stages, thress casks oil ex our stages, our motor boat rode out the gale safely other boats drove into the pond and more broken up, 500 blis hoops that was on Gov't Wharf belonging to Francis Penny, Keels was washed overboard and some casks cod oil belonging to Edwin Brown's the wreckage including our lighter the bridge from the brook skids from Govt Wharf wharf stocks and old spars from our docks was driven up to the head of Harbor Pond breaking down garden fences.

At Keels Meshs Schooner Mary Jones was lost, stages carried away and some 10 or 12 men who were preparing to go in the Bay and had their winter provisions in their stages lost all, a number of men lost their motor boats more lost a quantity of fish and other property.

At Stock Knight's Cove nearly every erection by water side all gone with motor boat and all fishing gear Pierce Heaney of Canary at Plate Cove lost 300 qtls Labrador fish motor boat and skiff, several Schooners and small crafts wrecked viz Lillian Ena and others

Open Hall, Red Cliff Island and Tickle Cove swept store flakes & c all down, boats lost fish and fishing gear and all kinds of property swept away entailing heavy losses
