THOMAS HUENER

Thomas Huener is currently a visiting professor of music at Memorial University, teaching trumpet, theory, and brass literature. Since coming to St. John's he has also served as Principal Trumpet in the Newfoundland Symphony Orchestra and appeared as soloist with the N.S.O. Sinfonia.

A native of the midwest, Mr. Huener received his education in Iowa, Michigan, and Illinois. He holds a B.A. from Kalamazoo College, a M.Mus. in composition from Southern Illinois University, studying with Will Bottje, and an M.F.A. in trumpet performance from the University of Iowa where he studied with David Greenhoe. He has actively pursued an interest in early trumpet literature and performance practice which has led to study and performance on the natural baroque trumpet as well as it's modern counterpart. Mr. Huener is currently completing a Ph.D. in music theory at the University of Iowa.

Prior to his arrival in Newfoundland he has been active as an orchestral and chamber musician, performing with the Quad City Symphony, the Old Capitol Brass Quintet, and, most recently, with the Central Michigan Brass Quintet and as Co-Principal Trumpet of the Midland Symphony Orchestra.
