**The Atlantic Arts Trio**, comprised of Carolyn Hart, soprano, Paul Bendzsa, clarinet and Edmund Dawe, piano, is celebrating its tenth anniversary as an ensemble with a tour of Atlantic Canada. The Trio was formed in 1987 and has toured extensively in several countries. Invitations from the High Commission for Canada in London (1987) and Hong Kong (1992) led to highly acclaimed performances throughout Great Britain and Asia.

Timed to coincide with Canada Music Week (November 17-24, 1996), the Trio has commissioned three composers from the Atlantic provinces to highlight its celebration: Alasdair MacLean, Clark Ross and George Langdon.

The Trio will present concerts in St. John's NF, Sackville NB, St. John NB, and Halifax NS. The Ensemble gratefully acknowledges touring and the commissioning assistance of the Canada Council, the Arts Branch of the New Brunswick government, and the Newfoundland and Labrador Arts Council.
