Jane Leibel holds a doctorate in vocal performance from the University of Michigan. She also has a master's degree from the University of North Texas, a bachelor of music degree from the University of Regina, and an opera diploma from the University of Toronto. Dr. Leibel won first prize in the Eckhardt-Grammaté National Voice Competition in 1990. Her performing experience includes operatic and concert appearances with the Toledo Opera Company, Opera Pacific, Vancouver Opera, Manitoba Opera, and Opera In Concert (Toronto). Dr. Leibel joined the MUN School of Music in the fall of 1999 where she teaches voice and lyric diction.

Maureen Volk began her piano studies in Saskatchewan, and received her bachelor of music degree from the University of Regina. With the assistance of The Canada Council, she continued her studies at The Juilliard School in New York, where she received her master of music degree, and at Indiana University, where she completed her doctorate in 1992. Her principal teachers have been Sasha Gorodnitzki, Shigeo Neriki, and most recently, Edna Golandsky. She was director of MUN's School of Music from 1990-2000.
