MUN Chamber Orchestra conductor and cellist **Vernon Regehr** joined the music faculty in September of 2003. In February, Vernon was called in on 24 hours notice to perform at a gala fundraising concert at Toronto's Royal Conservatory of Music with faculty members and internationally renowned pianist Leon Fleisher. Other recent performances include concerts at the University of Victoria, the Artspring theatre on Salt Spring Island, BC and the Kinhaven Summer Music festival in Vermont, where he is also on the teaching faculty. He also served on the teaching faculty at the Opus 118 String program in East Harlem, which was featured in the 1999 film 'Music of the Heart', starring Meryl Streep.

Vernon has participated in numerous summer festivals including the Tanglewood Music School, the Taos School of Music, the Colorado College Conservatory and the Oberlin Conservatory program in Italy. He recently conducted the New Year's gala at the Ford Centre for the Arts in Toronto and conducted the film score for a 2001 Sundance Film festival production.

Sean Rice is a fourth year performance major currently studying clarinet with Paul Bendzsa at Memorial University of Newfoundland. At MUN, he plays principal clarinet with the Concert Band and Chamber Orchestra and is a member of the Clarinet Quintet. Sean first began playing clarinet under the instruction of Vincenza Etchegary and later studied privately with Sean Carroll.

In 2002 Sean was selected to perform in the CBC national radio series 'Up and Coming'. In 2001, he received the Yamaha Rising Star Award and played lead saxophone in the Yamaha All Star Jazz Band at Musicfest Canada. In 2000, he competed in and won the Woodwind Category of the Canadian Federation of Music Festivals National Music Festival. Sean has been an active participant in the local Kiwanis Music Festival winning three Rose Bowl's: one Junior (2000) and two Senior (2001 & 2003). Sean has also received runner-up in the 2000 and 2001 Atlantic Debut Young Artists Competition and placed first in the 1999 and 2000 Provincial Music Festivals.

Sean recently performed with the National Arts Centre Orchestra while they were in St. John's on their 2003 Atlantic Tour, and was featured soloist with Symphony Nova Scotia during the Atlantic Scene Festival in Ottawa. As a part of that festival, Sean also performed a recital with MUN pianist Patrick Cashin.
